Although we are still praying that the Lord will allow us to secure our own building, we believe renting will be the most realistic to continue Bible Studies, start the coffeehouse and offer worship services. We have knocked on a lot of doors and made a lot of calls as well as enlisted the help of several

others to no avail. Just this past week I called an owner who not only took my call but also was relatively open to what we wanted to do. This alone got me excited. He told me that there is a list of people interested in this building that sits vacant behind the one he now uses. I'm not surprised Corktown is becoming a popular place



as we anticipated 18 months ago. But when I told him we wanted to start a church, he wanted to help us. It is still a long shot but still the most encouraging response we have had in several months. *Please ask the Lord to move us to the top of the list so we can begin to minister to Corktown.*

This week I also had the opportunity to speak to a pastor of a multi-ethnic church a couple miles east of the city. It has existed 55 years. He told me that Corktown was "*the zone of avoidance*" for church plants. The reason being is the hardness of the spiritual soil. That is exactly why we are here. God is able and we will do the labor necessary to see fruit as we did in Chicago! Please pray the hearts in this neighborhood will be broken and open to the Gospel!
